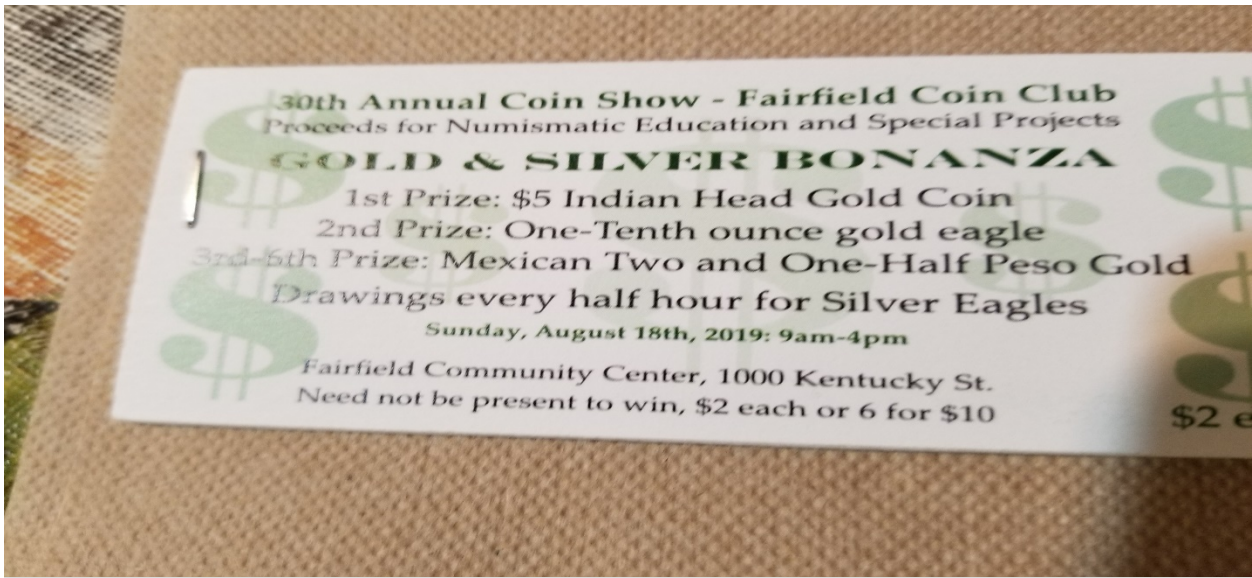
ATTENTION
