CSNA AND NCNA JOINT EDUCATIONAL FORUM

The California State Numismatic Association (CSNA) has joined the Northern California Numismatic Association (NCNA) to sponsor together the ‘CSNA/NCNA Northern California Numismatic Forum’ on Saturday, September 14, 2019 in Vallejo, California at the Vallejo Naval and Historical Museum’s upstairs Heritage Theater. The event was originally an NCNA only activity named ‘California Numismatic Seminar’

The theme for the Forum is *‘Transportation Numismatics’*. The four presenters are **Geoffrey Bell**, from New Brunswick, Canada, *‘Banks On Wheels’*, **Jeffery L. ‘Jeff’ Shevlin**, from Carson City, Nevada, *‘So-Called Dollars With Transportation Themes’*, **Kyle W. Lubke**, from Palo Alto, California, *‘Transit Of Ancient Coins’*, and **Matthew L. Malvini**, from San Jose, California. *‘San Francisco Transit Tokens In 1906’*. The first two might be called the ‘old guys’, since Kyle and Matthew, respectfully 24 and 19, could be called ‘the kids’.

This is a FREE event, open all coin hobbyists. The Museum would be also open free to all attendees as well as the California State Numismatic Association (CSNA) Library which is housed inside the Museum. There would be Door Prizes and an on-site simple lunch service. Also, to encourage attendance, there will be a special drawing for local coin clubs, too. Registration begins 8:30 AM. The first two presenters would be in the morning hours, starting at 9:30 AM. Afternoon presenters would start at 1:30 PM.

“CSNA is quite pleased that its compatriot sojourner NCNA welcomed and enticed our participation and presence with this joint event, which we hope might be repeated in 2020,” commented Dennis J. Hogan, CSNA President. “This is an excellent opportunity to collaborate and to promote our mutual hobby with another numismatic organization,” he added.

“NCNA hopes this joint event would enhance both organizations and the educational missions of the two,” remarked ‘Doctor’ Lloyd G.
